Victory for DC Housing!

On October 21st, the Council of the District of Columbia finished its work the RENTAL Act, securing a landmark victory for housing affordability and availability. Through relentless advocacy, DCAR secured the support of nine Councilmembers on an amendment to exempt very small housing providers from the Tenant Opportunity to Purchase Act (TOPA). As amended, the RENTAL Act delivers for our members by:

- Exempting Small Housing Providers from TOPA: Buildings with fewer than four housing units not owned by a business corporation will be exempt from TOPA.
- in eviction cases.
 Protecting Public Safety: Evictions will be accelerated in cases where there is a dangerous

• **Requiring Protective Orders:** Tenants can be required to pay their rent into the court registry

- or violent crime in the housing.
- Accelerating Evictions: The time a housing provider must wait before filing for eviction for non-payment of rent will be reduced to 10 days and the time for summons to be served before the initial hearing will be 14 days. Courts will not be forced to dismiss cases due to technical errors.
- Exempting new buildings from TOPA: New housing will be exempt from TOPA for 15 years after receiving a permanent certificate of occupancy.
- **Simplifying TOPA:** Owners can more easily transfer financial interests in properties, provide notice to tenants, and utilize template agreements.

Councilmember Anita Bonds explained that it "addresses an important aspect of homeownership, family wealth building; it can increase the number of housing units available to our residents; and it assures that naturally affordable housing remains and expands in every part of the city."
